

2010 Luverne Cardinal Classic Rules

- Halves will be eighteen minutes. Overtime periods will be two minutes with a maximum of two two-minute overtimes, then sudden victory.
- There will be two 30-second time-outs per half and one per overtime period.
- Boys teams in both 7th and 8th grade will use a men's basketball
- All technical fouls will result in the automatic awarding of two points to the opposing team, plus the ball out-of-bounds. A player or coach receiving a second technical foul will be removed from the game.
- Coaches must remain in the bench area during games.
- The clock will stop at all time-outs and at the referee's discretion.
- The clock will stop at all whistles during the last two minutes of each half.
- The clock will stop on ALL shooting fouls.
- National High School Federation Basketball rules shall be used.
- Pressing will be allowed up to a 15 –point lead.
- Each team shall provide their own warm up balls. Game ball will be provided.
- Players may play up a grade; they may not play down. Players may play for one team only.
- Teams should be ready to play up to 20 minutes ahead of schedule.
- Pool Play winners will be determined by the following criteria:
 1. Overall Record
 2. Head to head competition
 3. Point Differential
 4. Coin Toss
- No protests will be honored. All referees decisions are final!
- NO TOLERANCE for unsportsmanlike like conduct- anyone parent, fan, coach or player displaying disrespect to officials or players will be asked to leave with no refunds granted.
